
## **OPOLOT JOSEPH AND OGIATUM CHARLES PETER**

The two children were given a cow in order to improve on their livelihood. The family's way of life also changed. They were given a mattress and some kitchen items to sustain them. The family are cell group members and their faith has also been strengthened.

They are only able to farm in other people's gardens in order to get money to afford for basic needs.

They are very good disciplined and hard-working children. During holidays, they always do garden work, helping their uncle to graze animals, fetching water and they respect elderly people.
