Farming

Farming has been one of the challenging sections. To improve the section, crop specialization emphasizing on marketable crops has been adopted. Gardening / farming is currently done on rented land that is good for groundnuts/ peanuts growing for good farm yields and profitability.

Moving forward, the idea is to expand cropping to a large scale and handle farming in two seasons each year. The pictures below show the nature of the gardens. Farming is being managed in house with a member of the board (Francis) helping out with insights and sharing of practical farming ideas.



Vegetable Growing

At the drip irrigation section, eggplant and Kale was transplanted. We have a challenge of continued provision of mulch, its not available now till grass matures. Unavailability of mulch has been a major hinderance to operation of the Farming Gods Way envisaged of mulch as much as possible. With sufficient rain there is no threat of loss of moisture from the plants. When the need arises the drip lines are turned on for the required time and intervals if it has not rained.

Inservice Teacher Training at Touch Primary School

The need for in service training was noted as necessary to build the capacity of teachers to Interpret curriculum, managing continuous assessment and empower teachers on how to make instructional materials (teaching learning aid) using local materials. The first training has been done and facilitated by MS. Alupo Immaculate, a teacher trainer and member of Touch Ministries board. The training was conducted on **1st June, 2019** at Touch Primary School.
